64.01 TURNING AT INTERSECTIONS. The driver of a vehicle intending to turn at an intersection shall do so as follows:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.311)

1. Both the approach for a right turn and a right turn shall be made as close as practical to the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway.
2. Approach for a left turn shall be made in that portion of the right half of the roadway nearest the centerline thereof and after entering the intersection the left turn shall be made so as to depart from the intersection to the right of the centerline of the roadway being entered.
3. Approach for a left turn from a two-way street into a one-way street shall be made in that portion of the right half of the roadway nearest the centerline thereof and by passing to the right of such centerline where it enters the intersection. A left turn from a one-way street into a two-way street shall be made by passing to the right of the centerline of the street being entered upon leaving the intersection.

The Police Chief may cause markers, buttons or signs to be placed within or adjacent to intersections and thereby require and direct, as traffic conditions require, that a different course from that specified above be traveled by vehicles turning at intersections, and when markers, buttons or signs are so placed, no driver of a vehicle shall turn a vehicle at an intersection other than as directed and required by such markers, buttons or signs.

64.02 U-TURNS. It is unlawful for a driver to make a U-turn except at an intersection; however, U-turns are prohibited within the Business District and at intersections where there are automatic traffic signals.

64.03 LEFT TURN FOR PARKING. No person shall make a left-hand turn, crossing the centerline of the street, for the purpose of parking on said street; and no person shall back out of a parking space and cross the centerline of the street for the purpose of continuing travel in the same direction or the opposite direction. This prohibition shall apply only to persons intending to park in the following areas:

1. The west side of Lawler Street between Tilden Street and Greene Street.
2. The north and south sides of West Greene Street between Lawler Street and Reynolds Street.
3. The south side of East Greene Street between Lawler Street and Maple Street.
4. The north and south sides of East Williams Street between Lawler Street and the north-south alley immediately east of Lawler Street.
5. The south and north sides of West Williams Street between Lawler Street and Reynolds Street.

6. The north side of East Tilden Street between Lawler Street and the north-south alley immediately east of Lawler Street.
